1. Policy Limitations

- a. The program is only available to Village of Weston residents.
- b. The program only applies to feral/stray cats trapped in the Village of Weston.
- c. The program **does not** apply to domesticated cats.
- d. The program only applies to feral cats - no other animals.
- e. The Village of Weston assumes no responsibility for trapped cats spayed/neutered, cats should be released where they were caught.

2. Selecting a Veterinary Clinic

- a. The Village of Weston does not mandate where residents take cats for TNVR services, but the clinic (and paperwork received) must indicate the following services performed.
 - i. Rabies vaccine
 - ii. Spay/neuter service
 - iii. Left ear tip
- b. Failure to demonstrate any of the above services on invoices shall result in denial of reimbursement.

3. Reimbursement Procedure

- a. To be eligible for reimbursement, residents must submit the following paperwork to the village:
 - i. Reimbursement request form (provided by the village).
 - ii. Proof of residency in the Village of Weston (driver's license, utility bill, etc.).
 - iii. Receipts from a veterinary clinic demonstrating TNVR service (left ear tip, rabies vaccine, and spay/neuter service).
- b. Reimbursement will be remitted at a maximum of \$100 per eligible cat.
- c. Reimbursement will be remitted by check. Please allow 10 business days for check arrival.
