Backyard Fire Pit Regulations

1. Fires are allowed in yards of single- and two-family dwellings
2. Fire must be contained in a fire pit that is constructed of noncombustible material such as stone or steel. The pit cannot be more than 3 feet in diameter, and fire cannot extend more than 2 feet above the top of the pit
3. Only clean, dry, untreated, and unpainted wood can be burned.
4. All recreational fires must be a minimum of 10 feet from a lot line and 25 feet from a building or combustible fence.
5. Fire shall not be started nor allowed to burn if wind speed is greater than 7MPH and/or creates a nuisance for neighbors.
6. Fire suppression equipment shall be immediately available.
7. Fire must be attended by an adult at all times
8. Fire shall not be allowed to burn between 12 AM and 12 PM



Controlled Burning Regulations

1. Controlled burning of forestry materials, prairies, agricultural materials, etc., is allowed. Burning of other materials, such as building supplies, treated lumber, and general trash, is not prohibited.
2. At least 5 acres of property must be owned, under single ownership, in order to conduct controlled burning.
3. A burning permit must be obtained from the fire district
4. Fire suppression equipment shall be immediately available
5. Smoke may not create a hazard for motorists nor annoy neighbors
6. Burn permits may be canceled at any time by the Fire Chief.
