### **Village of Weston Restricting Access to the Municipal Center**

Both the [State of Wisconsin](#) and [Federal Government](#) have issued declarations of emergency due to public health concerns about COVID-19. Guidelines on protective measures to limit the spread of the virus are available on the [CDC website](#).

In the interest of protecting the health of the public, Village staff, and Village officials, the Village of Weston is limiting access to the Municipal Center at 5500 Schofield Avenue.

**Effective at 2:00 PM today, March 17, 2020, doors normally open for public access to the Municipal Center will be locked.**
