At their meeting of May 18th, 2020, the Village Board of Trustees discussed re-opening plans. This discussion was not as a specific item on the agenda but, as the report from Administrator, Keith Donner, to the Board. While initial discussion was for opening by a specific date, after lengthy discussion the item was advised for further review.

In a May 22 report to the Board of Trustees and all employees, the Village Administrator has advised a deliberate approach to “re-opening” access to the Village Municipal Center.

Although the Village of Weston is a local governmental entity, the effects of the current COVID-19 situation have caused businesses in all sectors of the economy to re-assess the “new normal” of doing business.

The public is advised that access protocols to the Village of Weston Municipal Center are still being evaluated. As further information becomes available, the most prudent measures of protecting the health of the public, Village staff, and Village officials, will be determined and implemented to the extent practical. **Until further notice the Village of Weston will continue closure of the following facilities to the public:**

The Municipal Center at 5500 Schofield Avenue.

All Park restrooms.

Due to the current level of uncertainty Park Shelter reservations will be refunded for anyone having made reservations through June 30th, 2020. Reservations may be taken for later this summer as the situation changes.

All Park spaces, Playgrounds, etc., other than Restrooms, are open for patrons to use at their own discretion UNDERSTANDING THE VILLAGE OF WESTON IS NOT ABLE TO DISINFECT THE FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT AND WILL NOT BE DOING SO.
