A RESOLUTION TO CHANGE THE NAME OF SCHOFIELD AVENUE

WHEREAS, Schofield Avenue is the main thoroughfare in the Village of Weston.

WHEREAS, using the name Schofield Avenue for this main thoroughfare has caused confusion with visitors, businesses and residents alike as to which community they are actually located in for many years.

WHEREAS, in 2017 the Village looked to rename the street via Resolution No 2017-011.

WHEREAS, this change did not occur due to the Village changing their participation in the Marathon County Addressing Project and the other two communities not being receptive to the change proposed at the time.

WHEREAS, some of the Trustees felt the street name was still an issue and causing confusion with businesses and resident and requested staff to look into the process for changing the name.

WHEREAS, President Maloney and Trustees Xiong and Zeyghami have requested the full Board of Trustees look again at changing the name of Schofield Avenue to end confusion and create a better community identity.

WHEREAS, they are proposing to change the name of Schofield Avenue to DC Everest Blvd.

WHEREAS, the full Board of Trustees reviewed this request at their August 16, 2021 Regular meeting to consider this name change.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Weston, in the State of Wisconsin, as follows:

NOW BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustee for the Village of Weston hereby request Schofield Avenue within the Village of Weston limits be renamed to DC Everest Blvd effective January 1, 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Board of Trustees for the Village of Weston directs the Administrator and Planning & Development Director to conduct the following activities:


1. Notify and assist individuals affected by the renaming with transition information and guidance that will help make the necessary changes to their address.
2. Notify Marathon County, EMPD, SAFER, the US Postal Service and other relevant agencies of the name change.
3. Implement the street name change with the fabrication and installation of new street signs by January 1, 2022.
